Major Responsibilities

- Partnership Support: meets regularly with Social Justice Teams and with community partners, helping foster
 powerful relationships based on mutuality, relationship and commitment to the values and goals we share.
 This includes and is not limited to managing activities such as "Share the Plate" and regular evaluation of our
 partnership programs and initiatives.
- Incubation/Program Development: works closely with congregants, staff, Minister(s) and community
 partners to support the development of new programs and initiatives. Provides training, resources, and other
 support to assist in achieving our congregational vision for social justice and the goals set forth in our
 strategic plan.
- Mobilization: stays connected to social justice groups within the DMV area. When necessary, the coordinator
 will provide recommendations and discernment on community social justice actions. Works to arrange an
 "emergency response team" who can act quickly on urgent requests and help mobilize the congregation for
 quick and effective collective action.
- **Multigenerational**: Will work with congregants, staff and Minister(s) to insure that people of all ages and stages can participate in meaningful ways in our Social Justice initiatives.
- **Anti-Racism**: will help coordinate our ongoing efforts to become a more anti-racist, interculturally competent and diverse congregation.

Skills/Qualities: The social justice coordinator should be skilled in training, consulting, community organizing, leadership development, group process, public speaking, relationship-building, and must be committed to antiracism and anti-oppression work. In particular, the coordinator will have experienced in different organizing paradigms, including emergent approaches and philosophies such as those used in the Black Lives Matter and Standing Rock movements.
